ADMITTING YOURSELF INTO THE PARKS

Complimentary self-admission into both theme parks is offered to eligible active U.S. based full-time, part-time and Casual Limited Employees and Operating Participants, as well as Retirees.

Bring your **company ID** issued by Disney, ABC, ESPN or another eligible U.S. segment, or your company-issued **retiree ID**.

SELF-ADMISSION:
Present your company ID or
retiree ID at the turnstiles.

- 1** Go to a Disneyland Resort theme park main entrance and present your **company ID** or **retiree ID** at any turnstile.
- 2** You will receive a 1-day **admission ticket**, for your use that day only for park entry and at *Disney's FASTPASS* kiosks.
- 3** **To re-enter or park hop:** When leaving the park you initially entered, obtain a handstamp at the exit turnstiles. Then, present your readmission ticket along with company or retiree ID at a theme park main entrance turnstile. Your handstamp will be checked.

Self-admission does not count toward your Main Entrance Pass usage total for the year. It is not subject to Main Entrance Pass block-out dates, but self-admission block-out dates are possible. Always check for this information prior to your visit (see below).

Although your spouse/domestic partner may admit themselves into the parks using their spouse/domestic partner pass, this is subject to Main Entrance Pass block-out dates and counts toward your annual usage.

All complimentary admission types are subject to **block-out dates**. Disney Employees can also check Main Entrance Pass block-out dates via smart phone or tablet by visiting blockoutdates.disney.com.

ADMITTING YOURSELF AND GUESTS INTO THE PARKS

Disney Employees, Operating Participants and Retirees:
Bring your Main Entrance Pass and company or retiree ID.

Spouses and Domestic Partners:

Bring your spouse/domestic partner pass and valid photo ID.

- 1** Go to a Disneyland Resort theme park main entrance and present your Main Entrance Pass along with your company or retiree ID at any turnstile. (Spouses and domestic partners must present their spouse/domestic partner pass along with valid photo ID.)
- 2** Identify the number of Guests in your party. Everyone in the party will receive a 1-day admission ticket, for use that day only for park entry and at *Disney's FASTPASS* locations.
- 3** **To re-enter or park hop:** Before leaving the park entered initially, everyone who is re-entering or park hopping must obtain a handstamp at the exit turnstiles. Then, present your readmission ticket(s) at a theme park main entrance turnstile. Your handstamp(s) will be checked, and Employees, Operating Participants and Retirees must also present company or retiree ID.

ADDITIONAL INFO

- Main Entrance Passes provide complimentary admission for the passholder and up to the number of Guests indicated on the pass.
- Each day your Main Entrance Pass or spouse/domestic partner pass is used for admission counts once toward your total annual usage.
- Spouses/domestic partners may use their spouse/domestic partner pass to admit themselves and Guests into the parks with or without the Employee being present.
- Spouses/domestic partners **may not** admit themselves into the parks after the Employee has already use their Main Entrance Pass to enter the park with Guest(s).
- Eligible Employees may self-admit themselves into the theme parks on the same day that the spouse/domestic partner enters with Guest(s). Follow the process on the previous page.
- Reusable Walt Disney World Guest Passes are neither needed nor accepted for entry at the Disneyland Resort theme parks.
